The Academic Model Providing Access to Health Care (AMPATH) is a program under the auspices of Moi Teaching and Referral Hospital (MTRH) and Moi University whose aim is to provide sustainable efforts in access to health care and to conduct research and training. AMPATH supports the Ministry of Health in ten (10) counties of Western Kenya, Nyanza and North Rift region.

Applications are invited for the following vacant position in the AMPATH population Health program.

POSITION: CLINICAL OFFICER INTERN-CDM PROGRAM (5 POSITIONS)

SITE: UASIN GISHU, ELGEYO MARAKWET, BUSIA AND BUNGOMA COUNTY

Reporting to the PI (**Principal Investigator**) and the **County Health Director** through the **Coordinator** the successful candidate will do the following;

Duties and Responsibilities

- Provide patient care for clients with chronic illnesses within the program catchment area
- Appropriately refer or admit patients who require hospitalization or specialized services.
- Undertaking clinical checks on all patient encounter forms, treatment sheets and prescriptions for suitability of patient care.
- Implementing Community Health Care activities in liaison with other health workers.
- Sensitizing patients, through health talks on preventive and promotive health.
- Facilitate scheduling of chronic disease clinics within the catchment area.
- Handle patient data / information with confidentiality
- Ensure proper documentation of patient information and accurate data entry; to paper form/ electronic system
- Participate in monitoring and evaluation activities for the program activities in their catchment region.
- Participate in continuous medical education on chronic diseases within their catchment region.
- Ensure patients who screen positive for chronic illnesses access care and are retained in care.
- Undertake other additional roles as may be assigned by the PI and immediate supervisors.



Qualification and Key Competencies

- Diploma in Clinical Medicine from a recognized Institution
- Certificate of registration and practice license from the Clinical Officers' Council
- Completed one year of academic internship.
- Must be a Kenyan youth aged between 21 and 28 years.
- Must not have been previously employed.
- Must have completed their training and graduated in the last two years.
- Cannot have another commitment during the period of the internship
- Proficiency in computer skills: word, excel & power point.
- Strong written and verbal communication skills.
- Experience in chronic disease management is an added advantage.
