### **RE: MATTERS ARISING.**

Following a circular released on 12<sup>th</sup> /October/2020, Ref NO: KMTC/CIR/7/VOLV. The SRC leaders received great deal of complaints and concerns as captured below.

- i. No clear reason for the prolonged period specified for finalist physical reopening.
- ii. There are no ongoing online classes as indicated and if it does its only 2% of the college population.
- iii. Students on practical/clinical placement areas were not given any directive.
- iv. The college did not give exact dates of FQE'S.
- v. Cohort 1.1 i.e. March/September 2020 to cohort 3.1 are in limbo and expected information on exact dates of resumption.
- vi. Students and parents/guardians are asked to pay fees for content not taught, or still not clearly explained since 1 Semester was lost.



The SRC leaders held a virtual meeting on 13<sup>th</sup>/ October/2020 at 8pm and agreed as follows:-

- a) Ask all the students and lecturers to stop online learning until the respective stakeholders explain in details its objective.
- b) Ask the respective stakeholders to meet and address the above concerns by **20/ October/2020.**
- c) Fees payment should be a reflection of semester objectively covered.
