Major Duties and Responsibilities

The community interviewers' responsibilities shall include and not be limited to the following:

- Conduct community sensitization meetings
- Assist with recruitment of participants to enroll in study
- Collect timely data using ODK
- Complete study forms accurately and completely
- Perform quality control checks on study forms
- Communicate with the Study Coordinator/designee on field issues
- Assist in participant follow up and home verifications
- Attend study meetings and report on progress of work
- Be courteous, respectful, proactive, conscientious, punctual, honest and hardworking
- Complete any other duties assigned or delegated by the supervisor.
