Post op
dislocation

Posterior dislocation of the hip joint

Occurs less commonly compared to anterior dislocation ✗ More common

Never damages the sciatic nerve ✗ - 4 anterior ✗

Very rarely associated with a fracture of acetabulum ✗ Fracture dislocation common

Should be managed by skin traction only ✗
