#### **Duties and Responsibilities**

- (iv) participate in the development/ review of undergraduate and postgraduate courses;
- (v) initiate, promote and participate in research projects;
- (vi) provide professional and community services, and initiate strategic training and research partnerships and linkages, and undertake fundraising for the University; and
- (vii) carry out administrative and such other duties and responsibilities as may be assigned from time to time.

#### **For appointment to this position, a candidate must:-**

- (i) have a Doctorate degree (Ph.D.) from an accredited/ recognized academic institution, with speciality in either Sociology, Healthcare & Legal Issues or Clinical Psychology;
- (ii) have a minimum of twelve (12) research publication output points from refereed scholarly journals and two (2) points from publications in conference proceedings;
- (iii) show evidence of evaluated effective teaching and / or research;
- (iv) show evidence of recognition and registration by the relevant regulatory body where applicable; and
- (v) show evidence of membership or affiliation of the relevant professional body where applicable.
